








WEBINAR ON CALIBRATION AND ITS ROLE IN BIOMEDICAL ENGINEERING

The speaker gave a brief discussion on all the aspects related to autism and its recovery. The session was an interactive and informative one. The session had 90 registrants from various colleges.




MEMBERSHIP DEVELOPMENT SESSION





WEBINAR ON ROLE OF SYSTEMS ENGINEERING IN MEDICAL DEVICE DEVELOPMENT


Date:5th May 2021


YP TALKS ON INSIGHTS ON APPROACHING PLACEMENTS

Date: 8th May 2021




