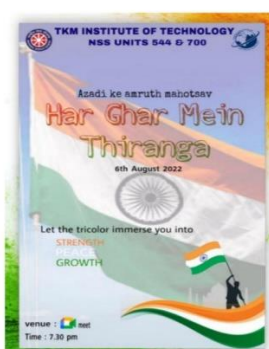
for the Event was Master. Adithya Suresh(ASIANET STAR SINGER FAME)Momentos were given and the charges were handovered to the new volunteer secretaries.

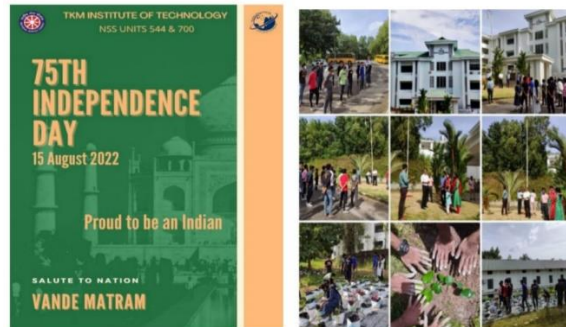


3.INDEPENDENCE DAY

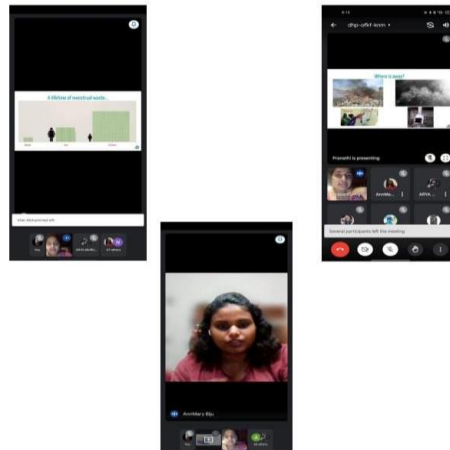
started with the hoisting of the National flag by Principal Jose Prakash. Along with the celebration, we also found time to take care of our vegetable garden.

-September, 2022

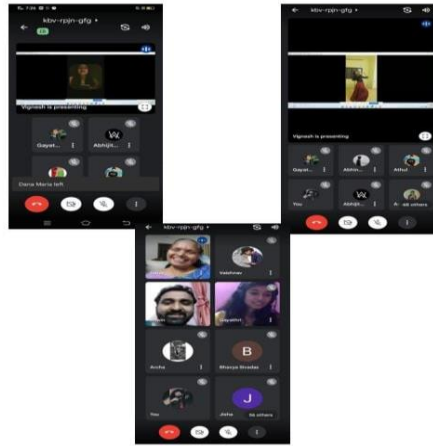

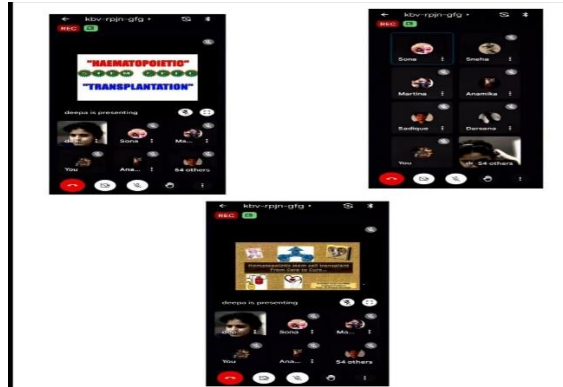
22. CANCER AWARENESS

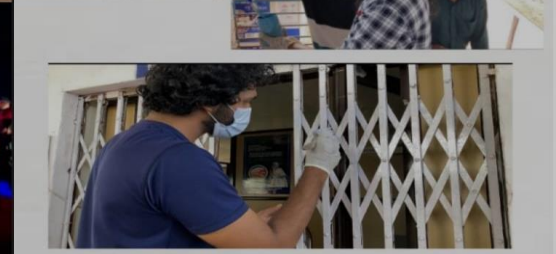
26.ARIKIL SEVEN DAY CAMP
