The meeting was adjourned at 11:30 AM, concluding a successful and memorable event.


SPARK@IEDC: ORIENTATION PROGRAM

Entries will be evaluated based on originality, clarity, and the persuasiveness of the presentation by a panel of experts. The competition runs from July 29th, 2024 to August 2nd, 2024. Participants can submit their ideas in the idea box placed in front of the store.

The winner of the competition will be awarded a first prize of 500. This initiative is a fantastic opportunity for TKMIT students to develop and pitch their innovative ideas, contributing to the entrepreneurial ecosystem of the institute.
