REPORT ON REGALIA 2023

On April 27 and 28, 2023, TKM Institute of Technology hosted Regalia'23, a two-day Techno Cultural festival. The art festival was an anticipated event that had been planned in advance. It offered a stage on which students could display their actual abilities and exquisite creativity while also revealing their true inner selves. Regalia'23 had the theme ISEKAI, a world of reflections in a parallel universe. The logo was introduced to coincide with Arts Day on April 18, 2023 with its tagline 'Cast Out'.

In addition to the main activities, Regalia'23 was jam-packed with several side events and competitions that were staged the preceding days in accordance with a well-planned schedule. Competitions and events included writing essays in English and Malayalam, digital painting, pencil drawing, water coloring, English extempore, treasure hunts, face painting, football 3-on-3, gaming, chess, poetry in English and Malayalam, mehendi design, idea pitching, and photography. DAY 1 — 27/04/2023
